REMOVE ALL PERSONAL PROPERTY FROM VEHICLE

This includes license plates. Please be sure to double-check console, boot, glovebox and small storage areas in doors.

FILL OUT AE FORM 190-1Z

Form must be filled out in triplicate (done at Auto Skills Center). You must be the owner or possess a Power of Attorney (POA).

TAKE PLATES, REGISTRATION AND FORM 190-1Z TO VEHICLE REGISTRATION

Form 190-1Z must be signed and stamped. Only one copy is needed here. Also bring lien release or POA if applicable.

BRING POV, KEYS, LIEN RELEASE & REGISTRATION

Registration must be current and either Permanent, Temporary or Non-Op. We cannot accept donations with expired registrations.

If vehicle requires towing, you must first stop by the Auto Skills Center to complete all required paperwork and make payment. We will provide you with the paperwork only after the vehicle has been picked up.

If you are unable to stop by for payment and paperwork, you will need to meet the tow truck driver at the vehicle during pick-up to complete the donation paperwork and payment in cash.

On-Post

Located on-post and within the USAG Wiesbaden area.

Off-Post

Located off-post, even if still inside the Wiesbaden area.
