

## UNIT TOURNAMENT BRIEFING TOPICS

1. **DRESS CODE:** Only soft spikes or spikeless golf shoes or smooth tennis shoes may be worn on the golf course. Cut-off shorts, tank tops, halter tops and BDUs are prohibited for male and female participants. Shirts and blouses will be worn at all times.
2. **POWER CARTS:** Carts should be kept at least 30 feet from greens and tees. Only two riders allowed per cart. Horseplay, racing, ramming, power braking and abuse of the course or equipment is prohibited.
3. **ICE CHESTS/BEVERAGES:** Ice chests and coolers are not permitted on the course. Only beverages purchased at the Clubhouse or through the beverage cart are permitted.
4. **CHILDREN:** Please call the office 548-5482 or pro shop 548-5485 for age requirements.
5. **MAKING THE TURN (9th to 10<sup>th</sup> hole):** Players stopping for more than five minutes after playing hole No. 9 lose position and right to proceed. This also applies in cases of shotgun start, 1st and 10<sup>th</sup> tee starts, when players pass by the Clubhouse. You have a maximum of four and a half hours to finish, but please encourage faster play. Keep up with the group in front of you and obey local rules and policies.
6. **RANGE BALLS:** Range balls are for use on the range only. **DO NOT USE THEM ON THE COURSE.** Balls cannot be removed from the facility.
7. **DIVOTS AND BALL MARKS:** Replace all divots and repair all ball marks on the greens. Rake the sand bunker after your shot.
8. **PROHIBITED PLAY:** Do not play a ball from areas marked “ground under repair” or “winter greens.” In case of inclement weather, especially when lightning is present, discontinue play and take cover until it has passed.
9. **TEAM CAPTAIN:** Each team should have a player with some golfing experience, to act as the team captain. His or her responsibility is to ensure the others in the group follow all rules and policies concerning carts, range balls, slow play and damage to the course.
10. **SCRAMBLE FORMAT:** All players hit from the tee. The team captain selects the ball in the best position. All players hit their next shot from this point. This will continue until the ball is holed. If any player intentionally or accidentally taps a short putt into the hole before all others have had a chance to putt, play ends for that hole and that score must be recorded. Only one ball will be used to record the team score.
