Cars are sold through Sealed Bid, Buy-It-Now or Open Auction. All the vehicles up for sale have been donated to the Auto Skills Center. Most vehicles are sold "as is" with no guarantee. Some vehicles may offer an inspection guarantee, so this should be considered when deciding on a purchase.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

THINGS TO CONSIDER BEFOR

Most vehicles will need work before they can pass inspection. We can help! Pay attention to the faults identified by the Auto Skills Center and remember: This does not guarantee that all faults have been identified. If it's a US spec car, parts will take longer to receive.

Make sure you have the money to pay for the car. You must pay within three working days after you are contacted or we reserve the right to contact the next bidder. US dollars, credit/debit cards and checks are accepted.

You will need to place the vehicle in storage if it needs to be registered Non-Op. This will cost \$2 per day.

You must register the vehicle with USAREUR within seven days of purchase. You will be issued 30-day temporary tags so you can drive the vehicle and go through inspection.

When we say "vehicle is sold as is" that means you accept the vehicle with all of its faults, both known and unknown. No guarantee is implied.

IPS FOR SMART BIDDING

Inform yourself about the vehicle you wish to bid on. Know the value of the car before bidding and consider what needs to be fixed and how much it will cost. To find the value of US spec cars you can go to Kelly Blue Book at kbb.com or NADA at nadaguides.com to get an idea of what you are willing to pay.

To estimate the value of European cars, you can compare prices at www.mobile.de. You can change the language to English on this site.

Make sure your point of contact information is correct and legible.

Check parts availability and prices. The Auto Skills Center can give you information on sources for both new and used parts.

Pay close attention to the faults listed by the Auto Skills Center staff posted in the vehicle window.
