Dialing Internationally

- **To dial a German commercial telephone from within the United States:** Dial 011 49 and drop the first 0 of the commercial number.
- **To dial a German commercial telephone number from within Europe, but outside of Germany:** Dial 0049 and drop the first 0 of the commercial number.
- **To dial a Defense Switched Network (DSN) number from outside of Europe:** Dial 314 + seven digit DSN

INSTALLATION ACCESS

Check-in and Check Out Base Procedures

All DODIDcard holders who are over 18 years old are able to sign-in individuals on base.

NATO Members, Department of State, and American Embassy Personal are not granted sign-in privileges unless stated otherwise by sponsoring organization

- ◆ For non DOD ID holders to be signed on base they must be accompanied by a DOD ID holder. They will have to provide their social security number and their passport.
- ◆ For local nationals to be signed on base they must be accompanied by a DOD ID holder. They will have to provide their passport or an official government ID.
- ◆ The Sponsor must monitor the activity of the individual they sign-in and are fully responsible for their conduct.
- ◆ Sign in privileges are limited to four individuals and one car per DOD ID holder.
- ◆ Failure to follow sign-in policy and procedures may result in the withdrawal of sign-in privileges.

- All pets living on post **MUST** be registered with the VTF upon arrival
- Please allow 72 hours when requesting prescription refills
- Due to limited manpower and resources, veterinary emergency cases are best served through a full-service local German veterinary hospital
- The VTF office provides an in-briefing for pet owners, which includes information on off-post veterinaries, boarding, grooming, obedience training, and other services



Pet Owner Information

Dog Keeping Laws in Germany

1. The use of any electrical devices for disciplinary purposes (fences, anti-bark collars, collars with remotes, etc) are not allowed
2. It is not allowed to permanently keep a dog in a box (like a crate or kennel); maximum allowed is 2 hours per day
3. A dog must have the following space available:

Required Floor Space based on height in CM

- Up to 50cm tall - 6 square meters
- From 50-65cm tall - 8 square meters
- More than 65cm tall - 10 square meters

Half of that mandatory floor space must be added for each additional dog kept in the same space

4. Tie stalls for dogs younger than 12 months are prohibited. If a dog is tie stalled, it must be at least 12 months old, completely healthy, and not pregnant. The tie must be:
 - Able to slide freely on a gadget allowing the dog to move with a distance of at least 6 meters
 - Attached so that the dog may go to its doghouse, lie down, and turn around. The dog must be able to move freely and without risk of injury. You may only use the wide harnesses or collars that do not incise, do not tighten themselves, and will not cause injuries.
 - You may use only ties that are safe from twisting. The tie must be made of light material and may not cause any injuries.
5. If you keep a dog outdoors, you must ensure that the following is available for the dog:
 - A doghouse made of thermally insulating material that is not detrimental to its health. It must be set up so the dog will not hurt itself and can lie down in a dry place.
 - The doghouse must be big enough so the dog can turn around and lie down comfortably. It must also be able to keep the shelter warm with its own body heat if there is no outside heating in the shelter.
 - Outside the doghouse there must be a spot to lie down in the shade, protected from the weather and with thermally insulated floors.
6. Your dog must have at least 2 hours of contact with its owner/care provider twice every day.
7. If your dog is kept in its kennel, in addition to the 2 hours of contact, it must have a chance to run freely for one hour.

To enjoy the benefits of this program, it's important to understand the process for using VAT forms. Sponsors must attend a briefing at the VAT office. During this initial visit, the sponsor can add family members to their VAT account and purchase VAT forms.

- The NF-1 VAT form costs \$10 and can be used for purchases up to \$2499.99
- Only 10 VAT forms can be checked out at a time, but once one is returned, the household is eligible to buy a new one.
- The NF-2 VAT form costs \$65 and is used for large purchases like cars. This is for purchases of over \$2,500. Requirements include quotes without tax and proof of the buyer's ability to pay.
- Any VAT form must be obtained before any payments to receive tax relief
- Items from the same vendor on the same day cannot be split across forms to avoid using an NF-2 VAT form

Keep in mind: Acceptance of the VAT forms by any vendor is voluntary. Forms are valid for two years, but cannot be used retroactively. Violating VAT rules can lead to a loss of privileges.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

If you need to claim VAT reimbursement for a hotel stay while waiting for permanent lodging, you have 7 DAYS IN COUNTRY to visit the VAT office and request this reimbursement.

- One/Two/Three Year Vehicle Transactions (Including initial registration, renewals, and transfers) are \$45/year
- Duplicate USAREUR registration fee is \$45
- Registration renewal late fee is \$25.00
- Payment can be made by check, money order, or debit/credit card

Annual Renewal:

- Safety Inspection: The POV must first pass a safety inspection
- Required Forms: AE Form 190-1o or AE Form 190-1AA
- Other documents: I.D. card, U.S. Forces Certificate of license and payment
- Power of Attorney: Required if the vehicle is in the spouse's name only
- Residency Requirement: Must be stationed or have an APO in Wiesbaden

Defense Department personnel stationed in Germany need an International Drivers License (IDL) along with a U.S. Forces Certificate of License (USAREUR License) plus a valid state-side driver's license to drive outside of Germany.

To obtain an IDL personnel must first get a USAREUR license at the Wiesbaden Driver's Training and Testing Station (DTTS). After completing the POV Orientation, passing the written test, and receiving the permanent USAREUR license, they should get an IDL application from DTTS. An IDL cannot be obtained with a temporary license.

Appointments for DTTS can be made by calling the office.

To complete the IDL process, applicants need:

- Signed IDL application from DTTS
- Passport Photo
- USAREUR License
- Official or Tourist Passport
- Valid state-side driver's license
- Department of Defense ID card
- Processing fee of 15 Euro

Passport photos can be taken at various locations for around 5 Euro. There is a photo booth on the far left end of the PX near Community Bank. The IDL is valid for up to three years or until the stateside license expires.



Youth Education

School busses are provided free of charge to students attending USAG Wiesbaden schools. To utilize school bus services, you must reside within the bus route boundary highlighted in the map below.

The walking distance for grades 5 and below will not normally exceed 1 mile from their primary residence to the school or designated bus stop. Students in grades 6-12 may walk up to 1.5 miles from their primary residence to the school or designated bus stop. These distances may be slightly expanded or contracted to conform to natural boundaries such as housing or neighborhoods.

School liaisons can provide support for your pre-K-12 education questions and concerns.

What is a school liaison?

School liaisons are located at each installation and are the main contact for military families, local school systems and installation leadership for school-related matters pre-K through 12th grade. School liaisons are experienced professionals who support, advise and build partnerships with the civilian and military community to help address common education challenges of military families.

Who is eligible for school liaison support?

School Liaison Program support is open to all War Department ID cardholders, educators who service military students and community partners involved with pre-K-12 education. Support is available to all uniformed services, including National Guard and reserves, those in geographically separated units, the Commissioned Corps of the U.S. Public Health Service and the uniformed members of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration.

What kinds of support do school liaisons offer?

School liaisons offer a wide variety of support to ensure the best possible education experience for military-connected students.

Services include:

- Transition support, including assistance with local school options, transfer of credits, youth sponsorship referrals and more
- Nontraditional schooling options, including home-schooling
- Special education support and referrals
- Deployment support
- College, career and military readiness
- Parent and educator workshops
- Military Interstate Children's Compact Commission, or MIC3, compliance
