MEMORANDUM FOR United States Army Garrison Wiesbaden, Child & Youth Services (CYS) Contractors and Other Space Available Patrons

SUBJECT: CYS Fee Policy School Year (SY) 2017-2018

- 1. Each year, the Department of Defense (DoD) reviews child care fees and prescribes uniform fee regulations for all military child development programs. This year's review determined that DoD contractors and other specified space available patrons, as defined in DoD Instruction 6060.02, "Child Development Programs (CDPs)," dated August 5, 2014, are no longer eligible for child care fee subsidies. This determination does not impact space available patrons who are active duty Military Service members with non-working spouses or DoD civilian employees, paid from Appropriated or Nonappropriated Funds, with non-working spouses, who are entitled to subsidies by virtue of their military service or DoD employment. Nonetheless, this change impacts weekly fees, multiple child discounts, and individual financial hardship waivers for many patrons.
- 2. In an attempt to ease the impact of this determination, the DoD and the Services have developed a phased plan for affected families. All current DoD contractors and other specified space available patrons will experience the same increase in fees as all other patrons during SY 2017-2018. However, all DoD Contractors and other specified space available patrons enrolling after December 31, 2017 will pay the Category IX contractor fee rate.
- 3. Child care fee subsidies will cease for all DoD Contractors and other specified space available patrons at the start of SY 2018-2019.
