*Mandatory participant briefings for all events will be conducted **10 minutes** prior to each scheduled start*

A: HUNT – (Scavenger Hunt)

The adventure will begin at the USO Cottage. **Teams of four to eight** will receive instructions and then be sent on their way. Your challenge will be to work as a team to find locations in Hainerberg Housing by deciphering clues and riddles. Each location will have a new riddle, puzzle or obstacle to solve. The team that completes the course in the least amount of time, wins.

Limited space available, **start times** will be assigned on a **first-come, first-served basis**.
