U.S. Army Garrison Wiesbaden welcomes back students – and parents and teachers – to the 2023 Back To School Week Aug. 14-20, leading up to the first day of school on Aug. 21.

Presented by Child and Youth Services of Family and Morale, Welfare and Recreation, and garrison community partners, the week's theme is "Back to Your Future" as students return to study, learn and pave their future. An actual DeLorean car from the iconic *Back to the Future* movie trilogy will be on display on base for the Back To School Week events.

The entire week before school starts – each day for seven days – a special back to school event or activity is offered. It kicks off Monday,



Aug. 14, from 4-6 p.m., at the Taunus Theater with a free showing of *Back to the Future* for youth of appropriate age accompanied by a parent. An alternate G-rated movie, *Meet the Robinsons,* will be shown for younger children with parents at Wiesbaden Elementary School. On Tuesday, Aug. 15, from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m., is Library Day for all ages at the Wiesbaden Library.

The garrison's Back To School Main Event is Wednesday, Aug. 16, from 2-6 p.m. at the park between the Hainerberg Mall and the Wiesbaden Middle School. It will feature the DeLorean, a Dad Jokes Tournament, live music and performances, food, games and information booths. The event is open to all U.S. military community families.

On Thursday, Aug. 17, from noon to 6 p.m. the Rheinblick Golf Course hosts "Driver's Ed." Parents and their children can hit two free baskets of balls at the reserved driving range.

On Friday, Aug. 18, from 4-6 p.m. their will be a Teachers Appreciation Social at the Wiesbaden Entertainment Center Lounge called "They're Baaack!"

On Saturday, Aug. 19, from 5-7 p.m. Armed Forces Entertainment presents Echosmith, the Southern Californian multi-platinum-selling alt-pop band on their Europe tour through Italy, Germany and Spain. They will perform and have a meet-and-greet outdoors at the Wiesbaden Sports and Fitness Center.

The last day before the first day of school, Sunday, Aug. 20, all four services at the Hainerberg and Clay Chapels will have special prayer and blessings for students, parents and teachers returning to school. Catholic Mass is at 9 a.m. and My Father's House Protestant Service if at 11 a.m. at the Hainerberg Chapel. A traditional Protestant Service will be held at 11 a.m. and a Gospel Service at 1 p.m. at the Clay Chapel.
