Family and MWR continues to expand range of services

As U.S. Army Garrison Wiesbaden began uncoiling its COVID-19 response measures in late June, community members were seeing the reopening of various programs and facilities throughout the garrison.

Child care for mission essential personnel, increased indoor and outdoor dining at local eateries, bay rentals at the Wiesbaden Automotive Skills Center and expanded services at the Wiesbaden Library were just a few of the available options.

Wiesbaden Entertainment Center — The Wiesbaden Entertainment Center reopened for bowling.

The **Warrior Zone** is open Tuesdays through Saturdays from noon to 8 p.m. The Warrior Zone is closed on Federal and Training Holidays. Maximum patron capacity at any one time is eight individuals.

Outdoor Recreation — The center, located in Building 3400

on Clay North, reopened with normal services. All **Hunting, Fishing and Sport Shooting programs** resumed. **Recreational Shooting** also resumed with social distancing in place on the ranges.

Automotive Skills Center — Self-service bay rental is available again. Customers can call the Auto Skills Center at civ (0611) 143-548-9817 to determine how much bay time they will need to complete their work. The Automotive Skills Center introduced **new hours as of July 14**: Tuesday to Friday noon to 7 p.m.; Saturday, Sunday and Training Holidays 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.; closed on Mondays and Federal Holidays.

Wiesbaden Library — The Library is again serving patrons in the facility. Face coverings are still required. The library is open Sunday to Thursday from 11 a.m. to 6 p.m. Registered library patrons can request materials online

and through the Army Europe Interlibrary Loan Program by logging into the Army MWR Library home page.

Rheinblick Golf Course — The Rheinblick Golf Course is open for play daily from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. All U.S. ID cardholders or co-use members may call (no email requests accepted) for a Tee Time seven days in advance. The **Rheinblick Restaurant** is open from 9:30 a.m. to 8 p.m.

The **Arts and Crafts Center** reopened its Wood Shop — by appointment only (call civ 0611-143-548-9838).
